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CALLING ALL ARTISTS

In keeping with the traditions of well-known Wetumpka artist Kelly Fitzpatrick and the Dixie Art Colony painters, the Elmore County Art Guild will host a juried art show “**Tallassee NOW RIVERFEST**” as part of the annual 2019 “Tallassee NOW” festival. The show is scheduled for Friday, June 7 from 6:00 pm until 8:00 pm and Saturday June 8, 2019 from 9:30 am until 2:00 pm in the old Patterson Building “RESTORATION 49,” which is located at 101 North Ann Avenue behind the downtown branch of Trustmark bank.

The theme, “**Tallassee NOW RIVERFEST**” encourages artists to focus on scenes of Tallassee’s and the surrounding areas. This year’s Elmore County Art Guild show will include a separate photography category. Awards will be in two categories. (Category I: Photography, Category II: All other two and three-dimensional works.) First, Second, Third and Honorable Mentions winners in both categories will receive ribbons. Monetary prizes will be given to First, Second and Third place winner in both categories. The “**Tallassee NOW RIVERFEST**” awards will given out at 11:30 am in the old Patterson Building “RESTORATION 49,” which is located at 101 North Ann Avenue behind the downtown branch of Trustmark bank.

The show is open to all artists 18 years of age and older. Up to five entries per artists will be accepted. ECAG members will be charged a \$8.00 entry fee per entry, and non-members will be charged a \$15 entry fee per entry. Artwork may be priced for sale or NFS. A 20 percent commission will go to the Elmore County Art Guild. All two-dimensional work must be dry, framed, and include a hanging wire. Gallery-wrapped canvases will be accepted as long as the sides are painted. Sculpture should be dry, fully assembled and ready to display. The artist is responsible for any special display stands or covers that might be required for their artwork. Fiber art requiring hanging must have supporting sleeve and rod to assist with appropriate display. It is recommended that each artist supply a CD with images of your artwork, especially for art under glass. The images will be to promote the show and the participating artists. Please include your name and title of your artwork with the CD. (PLEASE, NO ARTWORK OVER 36 INCHES IN WIDTH OR LENGTH.)

Membership in the guild is based on a \$35 annual investment. Memberships typically run from January 1 to December 31; however, artists that choose to join for this show will receive an extended membership through December 31, 2020. Membership in the ECAG includes juried art shows, monthly newsletters, email alerts of upcoming events, and the opportunity to display your work at several locations in Wetumpka. The Elmore County Art Guild will also host a youth show featuring the winners of the 2019 ECAG “**Sparking the Arts**” student competition from the **Tallassee City Schools**. The awards will be announced at 11:30 am on Saturday, June 8 in the old Patterson Building “RESTORATION 49,” which is located at 101 North Ann Avenue behind the downtown branch of Trustmark bank.

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In addition to the ECAG show, the **Dixie Art Colony Foundation** will host a joint exhibition in the Trustmark bank lobby at 304 Barnett Boulevard.

A reception and ECAG awards ceremony will be at 11:30 am in old Patterson Building "RESTORATION 49," which is located at 101 North Ann Avenue behind the downtown branch of Trustmark bank.
