- not to show any objectionable works that would offend persons of any age, race, or religion. Works are screened by the Armory Director or Arts Program Coordinator/Gallery Manager and shown at their discretion. The Arts Council of Montgomery hereby reserves the right to refuse to display any works deemed objectionable. *The Learning Arts Center is open to all the public, with daily programs for youth and children.*

Receptions are M-Th, however occasionally weekends can be arranged with available staff, at \$25/hr to ACM.

The Gallery will be open to the public **Monday through Thursday 8:30am – 4:30pm and Fridays 8:30am – 4pm** throughout the dates listed (except holidays). All artworks will be exhibited at the owner's risk. Neither the Arts Council of Montgomery nor the City of Montgomery will insure or be responsible for loss/damage to any work of art/personal item. The primary purpose of this gallery is to display works of art to enhance cultural experience and edify the relationship between visual art and public viewers. Works may be made available for purchase under these conditions:

- All sales of exhibited artworks are processed through the Arts Council of Montgomery office
- Checks are made payable to the Arts Council of Montgomery
- 25% of sales is retained by the Arts Council of Montgomery for continued upkeep of the Gallery; a check for the remaining 75% will be issued to the artist at the close of the exhibit. There is no fee to exhibit in the Anita P. Folmar Art Gallery of Montgomery.

ELMORE COUNTY ART GUILD

Founded in 1985, the Elmore County Art Guild, is the oldest art organization in Elmore County. Today, the membership is made up of approximately sixty diverse individuals with varying backgrounds and interest. Regular meetings, which include educational programs, are held on the second Wednesday of every month with the exception of June, July, and August. The Guild is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization as of July 31, 2011.

The primary objective of the Guild is to advance and promote the appreciation, enjoyment, and exhibition of the visual arts, for the mutual improvement, cultural benefit, and social enlightenment of Guild members and the public at large.

In addition to organizing annual adjudicated exhibitions, the Guild maintains regular ongoing exhibits with art for sale at several locations in Wetumpka and Millbrook. The Guild also sponsors several community outreach projects, including the annual Elmore County wide Sparking the Arts Student Achievement Program.

Membership in the Guild includes a monthly newsletter, email alerts, and a chance to display art for sale. Membership is open to anyone 18 years of age or older that is an artist or is interested in supporting and promoting the arts. Volunteering is one of the best ways you can support the Guild and contribute to its success. Several ways to volunteer are: serve on a committee, teach a workshop, assist with take-in and hanging of exhibitions, assist with receptions, and assist with publicity or fund raising.

Membership is \$35 for single, and \$45 for a couple. Checks should be made payable to **Elmore County Art Guild, P. O. Box 65, Wetumpka, AL 36092.**

All memberships begin on January 1st and expires on December 31st.
